- Q.4 "Grant of bail in cases not falling within the prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.P.C. is a rule while refusal is an exception." Discuss with reference to relevant provisions of law.

- Q.5 Explain the scope and extent of right of private defence of the body and of property exercisable by a person.
- Q.6 Compare and contrast the salient features of vicarious liability in furtherance of common intention and in prosecution of common object.
- Q.7 When theft or extortion becomes robbery? Elaborate with illustrations.
- Q.8 Give a brief account of punishments to which the offenders are liable under the provisions of Pakistan Penal Code, 1860.
